




Natural Sequence in the Commercialization Process



- 1. How far along is the company in the FDA timeline?
- 2. How much success has management demonstrated in previous ventures?
- 3. Who is on their advisory board and what success have they had?
- 4. Use of funds of the current \$\$ offering?
- 4. How much more money and time will it take to get to commercialization?
- 5. What medical publications support the science?

Observations & Trends from a Life Sciences Incubator Professional

"Investing in Life Sciences Early Stage companies in Florida is still strong; we see marked interest among angel investors and venture capital groups. More attention is being paid to the health sciences data sector, including cybersecurity for healthcare data, patient management applications, and disease management software. Early stage life sciences companies are also seeing significant corporate investment interest, as more large corporate partners see the value of investing as a development partner and thus paving the way for future acquisition of companies and their technologies".
